The fifth biennial LIMECONNECTION will be held in Darwin, Australia from 26-28 August, 2013.

The **Connection** will provide an opportunity to discuss and critique current practices and explore emerging tools and techniques to drive improvement in outcomes for Indigenous health, and aims to encourage information sharing, professional development, capacity-building and networking amongst peers. **LIMECONNECTION** seeks to support collaboration between medical schools and to build linkages with community, colleges and those from other health disciplines.

Keynote speakers will include experts in Indigenous health and medical education from Australia, Aotearoa/New Zealand and further afield. The target audience includes Indigenous and non-Indigenous medical educators, Indigenous health specialists, medical specialists, policy makers, students and community members.

The **LIMElight** Awards, which acknowledge and celebrate the many successes in the field, will also be presented at **LIMECONNECTION V**.

LIMECONNECTION V is co-hosted by Charles Darwin University and Flinders University and is held under the auspices of Medical Deans Australia and New Zealand, the Australian Indigenous Doctors' Association (AIDA) and Te Ohu Rata O Aotearoa (Te ORA) Māori Medical Practitioners Association of Aotearoa.

The **Connection** is an outcome of the Leaders in Indigenous Medical Education (LIME) Network. The **LIME** Network is a program of Medical Deans Australia and New Zealand, funded by the Australian Government Department of Health and Ageing. The **LIME** Network is hosted by the Onemda VicHealth Koori Health Unit within the Melbourne School of Population Health at the University of Melbourne.
